“Within the City of Charlotte, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services has an aggressive Pilot BMP program. The program is focused on determining the cost benefit, pollutant removal efficiency, and maintenance costs or requirements of various types of BMPs. Knowledge gained from evaluating these Pilot BMPs is part of an overall water quality management strategy for Charlotte-Mecklenburg watersheds.

Charlotte is always seeking opportunities to test new storm water control measures. During this Tech Talk, Charlotte staff will present the mechanics of the Pilot BMP program and initiate a discussion with Tech Talk participants in efforts to expand the borders of the testing area and possibly partner with other municipalities to reach common goals.”
