Dr Schwarz first entered college as a math major and shifted his focus from math to economics after developing an interest in public finance. He now specializes in Energy and Environmental Economics.

In 20xx, Dr. Schwarz undertook a project for Duke Energy which evaluated the pricing of electricity by time of use. The project was very rewarding to him as he helped save at least a billion dollars in electricity for the State of North Carolina.

Dr Schwarz was presented the Editor's Choice award for his work with Dr. Hilary Inyang in which he made use of software to handle regulations affecting electricity. He analyzed the 1990 Clean Air Act standards and the North Carolina Clean Smokestacks Act. He evaluated the projected costs of the new regulations and made a decision on conforming to the new Acts.

Dr. Schwarz also finds time to focus his expertise on a very different matter altogether. He authored a paper on the economics of pets!
